## **RECOMMENDATION**

County Counsel requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 5 to Agreement No. 4793 with John Dawdy increasing the amount by \$4,000 for a new maximum of \$14,000 to provide services as a Hearing Officer for Certification Review Hearings.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The County has contracted with John Dawdy since 2001 for the provision of services as a Hearing Office for Certification Review Hearings pursuant to Section 5256 et. seq. of the Welfare and Institutions Code. This amendment will increase the annual contract maximum by \$4,000 to a new maximum of \$14,000.

Discretionary Justification:	The amount of certification review hearings held at St. Helena Center for Behavioral Health, Napa State Hospital and Telecare Hospital Solano has increased over the last year and the compensation provided under the current contract is not enough.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT**

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

#### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

A Certification Review Hearing is held to determine whether an individual who has been detained in a mental health facility and found to be a danger to self or others continues to require further mental health treatment and evaluation. Pursuant to the Welfare and Institutions Code, Certification Review Hearing Officers must be unanimously approved by the County Public Defender, Mental Health Director and County Counsel. John Dawdy has been serving as the County's unanimously approved Hearing Officer since 2001.

The contract is being increased by \$4,000 for a new maximum of \$14,000 per fiscal year. The contractor will be paid a flat rate of \$1,000 per month for services provided at facilities other than St. Helena Hospital. An additional \$2,000 is included in the contract to cover travel related expenses and hearings at St. Helena Hospital when requested.
