**SUBJECT:** Amendment No. 2 to Agreement with Linda Bancke, Ph.D.

---

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Director of Health and Human Services requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. 1885 with Linda Bancke, Ph.D., increasing the amount by \$4,000 for a new maximum of \$68,200 for Fiscal Year 2004-2005, incorporating agency-wide changes to the General Terms and Conditions, revising the Scope of Work to include additional hours for assessments and testimony, and establishing a maximum of \$87,500 for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 to provide psychological evaluation services to clients in the Children's Programs.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Dr. Bancke is a licensed psychologist who provides court-ordered psychological assessments and testimony concerning Child Protective Services and Children's Behavioral Health clients. The assessments are necessary in order to have accurate information with which to make child safety decisions.

automatic renewal, which allows the County the option to continue these services into the next fiscal year.

### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

Dr. Bancke provides written psychological assessments and court testimony as mandated by the court regarding child abuse issues for specific families that are referred to her.

The amendment for Dr. Bancke includes:

- | An increase in the maximum dollar amount to provide additional units of court-ordered services for the remainder of this fiscal year;
- | Revisions of the Scope of Work to include additional hours for assessments and testimony;
- | A rate increase for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 from \$70 per hour to \$90 per hour;
- | Establishment of the maximum dollar amount for Fiscal Year 2005-2006; and
- | Agency-wide changes to the General Terms and Conditions.

The department has an executed Business Associate agreement on file with this provider.
