**SUBJECT:** Registrar of Voters requests Board declare elected those persons under its jurisdiction based on June 5, 2012 Presidential Primary Election certified results

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### **RECOMMENDATION**

Assessor-Recorder-County Clerk in his capacity as ex-officio Registrar of Voters requests that the Board declare elected those persons under its jurisdiction based on the certified results of the Presidential Primary Election held on Tuesday, June 5, 2012.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Elections Code Section 15372 provides that the elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the Presidential Primary Election held on June 5, 2012 and submit it to the governing body within 28 days of the election. The Assessor-Recorder-County Clerk in his capacity as ex-officio Registrar of Voters sent the certified statement to the Board of Supervisors on June 26, 2012, which is within the 28 days period. In addition, Elections Code Section 15400 provides that the governing body (Board of Supervisors) shall declare elected those persons under its jurisdiction based on those certified results. The list of persons elected is attached.

Because no candidate received a majority of the ballots cast in Supervisor District 2, the declaration of election in that contest will be prepared following the November 6, 2012 Presidential General Election.

All other contests and propositions on that ballot are to be declared at the state level.
