### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Pursuant to Napa County Code Section 2.04.080 each member of the Board of Supervisors shall designate not less than three emergency interim successors to his/her office and specify their rank in order to succession.

## **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

Pursuant to Napa County Code Section 2.04.080 each member of the Board of Supervisors shall designate not less than three emergency interim successors to his/her office and specify their rank in order to succession.

Board incumbents shall review and, as necessary, promptly revise the designations of emergency interim successors to ensure that at all times there are at least three such qualified emergency interim successors for each member. Each Board member was surveyed and provided their list of interim successors.
