RECOMMENDATION

Human Resources Director requests adoption of a resolution approving a cost of living adjustment of 3.0% for Law Enforcement and Law Enforcement Supervisory units effective July 2, 2005.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2004, the Board approved Total Tentative Agreements with all of its bargaining units. The Total Tentative Agreement reached with Law Enforcement and Law Enforcement Supervisory units calls for a 3.0% cost of living increase effective in July.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Board of Supervisors approved a Total Tentative Agreement in October 2004 with Law Enforcement and Law Enforcement Supervisory units. This agreement is for a three (3) year term. The Board approved a cost of living adjustment of 3.0% for each year of the Agreement.

The resolution before you today approves amending the Table and Index to include the cost of living increase for all Law Enforcement and Law Enforcement Supervisory unit employees effective July 2, 2005.
