BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

On June 1, 1999, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 99-56, authorizing the Library Director to accept on behalf of the Napa County Library donations of money and gifts of \$2,000 or less to support existing Library services and programs.
