RECOMMENDATION

Human Resources Director requests adoption of a resolution regarding the following in connection with the Environmental Management Department, effective August 6, 2005:

- 1. Amend the Departmental Allocation List to add one (1) Acting Director of Environmental Management;
- 2. Amend the Table and Index to add Acting Director of Environmental Management; and
- 3. Appoint Jill Pahl as Acting Director of Environmental Management.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The position of Director of Environmental Management became vacant on August 1, 2005. A recruitment will be conducted to fill the vacant Director's position, but appointment of a successor is not anticipated immediately. To enable the department to continue to operate effectively during the interim, the Human Resources Director, at the direction and with the approval of the County Executive Officer, recommends the Board allocate an Acting Director position and appoint the Assistant Director, Jill Pahl, as Acting Director of Environmental Management, effective August 6, 2005.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

A recruitment will be conducted to fill the vacant Director's position, but appointment of a successor is not anticipated immediately. To enable the department to continue to operate effectively during the interim, the Human Resources Director, at the direction and with the approval of the County Executive Officer, recommends the Board allocate an Acting Director position and appoint the Assistant Director, Jill Pahl, Acting Director of Environmental Management effective August 6, 2005. Ms. Pahl will assume all associated duties and responsibilities of the position, and will serve as Acting Director until a permanent replacement is found.

The Acting Director of Environmental Management position will be deleted from the Departmental Allocation List and the Table and Index upon the effective appointment of the Director of Environmental Management.
