## **RECOMMENDATION**

Director of Health and Human Services requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign an agreement with Chateau Hotel Napa Valley for a maximum of \$3,200 for meeting room rental fees to conduct stakeholder training, planning and priority setting for the Mental Health Services Act on September 12, 19 and 26, and October 3, 2005.

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

HHSA is hosting a four-part work group meeting to provide stakeholder training and education and to gather stakeholder input for the development of Napa County's Three-Year Community Services and Support Plan, which is a requirement of the Mental Health Services Act funding that Napa County has received from the State Department of Mental Health.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

#### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

HHSA's Behavioral Health Division is hosting a four-part work group meeting to train stakeholders on the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) requirements and to present County Mental Health program and service data. The goals of the meeting are to: (1) include community stakeholders in the County's MHSA planning process; (2) develop stakeholders' priorities for expanding mental health services in the County within the scope of the MHSA requirements; and (3) draft a Three-Year Community Services and Support Plan. The Plan is required and must be approved by the State in order for the County to obtain funding and implement the three-year Plan. Participants will include mental health consumers, family members of consumers, employees, community service providers, and other interested constituents of the County's mental health system.

Several meeting sites were evaluated. The Chateau Hotel Napa Valley's Conference Center was selected to accommodate the number of participants attending the sessions and to allow for specialized focus group discussions in multiple rooms.
