#### RECOMMENDATION

Auditor-Controller requests authorization to draw a warrant in the amount of \$40,000 from the Napa County Fair Fund, payable to the Napa County Fair, for the purpose of replenishing the Operating Fund for special projects on the fairgrounds.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Napa County Fair requests various actions throughout the fiscal year. These actions require Board of Supervisors' approval. The County Treasurer received \$40,000 from the Millennium Flex Program which needs to be distributed to the Napa County Fair. Authorization to disburse these funds is requested.
