In addition, responses previously transmitted to the Presiding Judge by the elected officials have been included. Those are responses by the Assessor-Recorder/County Clerk in his ex-officio role as the Registrar of Voters and the Sheriff. The Penal Code requires those responses be transmitted under separate cover no later than August 30, 2005.
