Director of Public Works requests authorization for the Chair to sign two Certificates of Acceptance of Easement Deeds from The Peter A. and Vernice H. Gasser Foundation pertaining to the South Napa Homeless Shelter Project. (Assessor's Parcel No. 046-691-004)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Gasser Foundation has executed two Easement Deeds to the County. These easements will provide driveway access, and are necessary for the contractor to continue construction and for the shelter to operate after completion of construction.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The South Napa Homeless Shelter project consists of a 56-bed, dormitory-style shelter within an approximately

The Gasser Foundation has executed two easement deeds to the County for public utilities and ingress/egress. These easements are necessary for the contractor to continue construction and for the shelter to operate after completion of construction.
