SUBJECT: Second Reading and Adoption of Electrical Code Ordinance

RECOMMENDATION

County Counsel requests second reading and adoption of an ordinance amending Chapter 15.28 (Electrical Code) of the Napa County Code, adopting the updated California Electrical Code and amending administrative provisions.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposed ordinance amends Chapter 15.28 to adopt the updated California Electrical Code without modification as provided for local building officials, including various optional provisions. The ordinance also proposes certain amendments to local administrative provisions which are not a part of the California Electrical Code.
