Additionally, Penal Code 4025 states an itemized report (attached to this agenda item) of Inmate Welfare Fund expenses shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors annually. BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Penal Code 4025 provides for the establishment and maintenance of a store to sell various goods such as confectionary foods, stamps, toiletries and other miscellaneous goods to inmates. Any profit derived from the sale of these goods to inmates is deposited in the Inmate Welfare Fund. Monies deposited in the Inmate Welfare Fund are expended for the benefit, education, and welfare of the inmates in the custody of the jail. Additionally, Penal Code 4025 states an itemized report (attached to this agenda item) of Inmate Welfare Fund expenses shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors annually. The Director of Corrections is presenting this report to the Board today for FY 2013-2014.

The Inmate Welfare Fund concluded FY 2013-2014 with \$204,107 in total expenses.
