BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Groundwater Sustainability Plan Advisory Committee (GSPAC) Bylaws (VI Meetings) require Regular Meetings of the GSPAC be held monthly as shown on a calendar, which the GSPAC shall adopt at its first meeting of each calendar year. Meetings shall be held in the Napa County Board of Supervisors Chambers at the Napa County Administration Building. The time of the Regular meetings of the GSPAC shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and continue until all agendized business is concluded unless adjourned earlier on motion of the GSPAC for any reason or by the Chair or Secretary for lack of a quorum or unavailability of a meeting location due to an emergency. Emergency meetings of the GSPAC shall be called in conformance with the provisions of the Brown Act (Government Code Section 54950 and following). Special meetings of the GSPAC shall be called in conformance with the provisions of the Brown Act, including 24 hour notice of the meeting posted at the regular meeting location, and in those local newspapers that have requested to be informed of GSPAC meetings.

The proposed 2020 Meeting Calendar suggests convening the GSPAC on the second Thursday of the month, as this is the best day the Board of Supervisors Chambers is available at 1:30 PM.
