RECOMMENDATION

County Executive Officer requests discussion and possible action on HR 3138, the State and Local Cybersecurity Improvement Act introduced by Representative Yvette Clark (D-NY).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The State and Local Cybersecurity Improvement Act would authorize a new Department of Homeland Security (DHS) \$500 million grant program to address critical cybersecurity challenges.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The State and Local Cybersecurity Improvement Act would establish a \$500 million DHS grant program. The legislation would also require State governments to develop comprehensive Cybersecurity Plans. Furthermore, the bill would bring together the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), State Governments, and Local Governments to better coordinate and identify cybersecurity needs and resources.

The legislation was passed in the House and is awaiting further consideration in the Senate.
