RECOMMENDATION

Authorize out-of-state travel to Minneapolis for Technical Services Director/District Engineer Andrew Damron and Associate Engineer Karl Ono for the purpose of attending the North American Society For Trenchless Technology (NASTT) Annual No-Dig Conference from April 10-14, 2022.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Annual NASTT No-Dig Conference will be held in Minneapolis from April 10-14, 2022. This conference specializes in trenchless technologies such as pipe bursting and cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining. The conference includes over 120 technical paper presentations and exhibiting companies available to answer questions and demonstrate cutting edge technology for our industry.

NapaSan staff continues to plan, design, and implement collection system rehabilitation projects using trenchless technologies. This conference provides an excellent opportunity to meet with experts, review new construction techniques, hear technical presentations about successful projects, and to learn why some projects were not successful.

At this conference in Minneapolis, staff will be presenting two papers on recently completed NapaSan projects (the 66-trunk CIPP rehabilitation; and the 2021 collection system rehabilitation project that used pipe bursting to rehabilitate asbestos cement pipe). NapaSan staff members who are scheduled to attend this conference have received scholarships that cover the cost of the conference registration and lodging.
