the Napa Commerce Center Development

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Concur with CEQA determination by Napa County, lead agency under CEQA for the development project; set bond amount at \$193,750; and authorize Chair to execute the Improvement Agreement and Private Main Agreement for the Napa Commerce Center development.

# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This development, by NCC Venture I, LLC, is for a 32.7 acre, 9-lot commercial subdivision at the parcel number 057-210-066 located south of Airport Boulevard between Devlin Road and Highway 29 in unincorporated Napa County. In order to provide sanitary sewer and recycled water service to this project, the developer will install private sanitary sewer and recycled water mains within the proposed development. NapaSan requires the developer to enter into an Improvement Agreement for the installation of sanitary sewer and recycled water facilities serving multiple parcels and a Private Main Agreement for the operation and maintenance of the proposed private sanitary sewer mains and laterals. The Private Main Agreement outlines the owner's responsibilities and will be recorded upon execution by all the parties.
