SUBJECT: Approve Sewer Service Charge Refund - 150 Westgate Drive

RECOMMENDATION

Approve refund of \$15,183.67 for FY 2014-15 to FY 2020-21 for sewer service charges for Assessor Parcel Number 061-021-001 located at 150 Westgate Drive.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The owners of 150 Westgate Drive have requested that their sewer service charges be adjusted for FY 2014-15 through FY 2020-21.

The owners purchased the property in the 1990s and have maintained the property as a single family dwelling since the purchase date. NapaSan records previously classified this parcel as an office and sewer service charges were calculated based upon commercial calculations for this parcel instead of the fixed rate for residential properties. In FY 2017-18, NapaSan revised the classification of the property to a single family dwelling but did not update the sewer service charges to reflect one (1) equivalent dwelling unit (EDU) for the property.

Although the owners have been erroneously paying sewer service charges based on water usage for most of the time they have owned the property, per District Code 5.01.080 Section A, NapaSan can only issue a refund within four (4) years from the date of the original payment. However, staff first discovered the error in FY 2017-18 and the owners would have been due a refund of four (4) years at that point back to FY 2014-15. Staff agrees that the parcel should have been charged one (1) EDU per fiscal year. The owners were charged \$19,454.15 for FY 2014-15 through FY 2020-21. Staff believes that the sewer service charges for those years should be adjusted down to the applicable rate for each year which totals \$4,270.48. The original charges were paid in full, therefore staff is recommending a refund in the amount of \$15,183.67.
