### **RECOMMENDATION**

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

A new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for NapaSan was recently adopted by the Regional Water Quality Control Board.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

**BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

This federal and state permit is reissued every five years and often contains new requirements with each reissuance. The permit renewal process usually takes approximately one and a half years from start to finish. Extensive negotiations were conducted on the current permit reissuance over multiple draft permits with a variety of Regional Water Board staff members. This new NPDES permit will become effective on April 1, 2022 and will expire on March 31, 2027. The next NPDES permit reissuance process will begin in 2025.
