RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute Amendment 1 to Task Order 31 with Psomas to provide construction inspection services for the Stanly Ranch Resort Project in the amount of \$72,301.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Psomas is providing construction inspection services for the Stanly Ranch Resort Project. Amendment 1 is necessary to provide additional inspection services due to an extended construction schedule.

Where is it budgeted?	Terms and conditions of annexation of Stanly Ranch into NapaSan's service area and conditions of approval of the resort project both require the developer to pay for inspection of the sanitary sewer and recycled water improvements. Due to the size and scope of the resort project, the developer is required to submit a deposit to cover the cost of construction inspection. The costs of the Psomas task order and amendment will be paid for by the developer.
