SUBJECT:	Award Task Order for the Pond Levee Maintenance Project (CIP 20707) Construction Management, Inspection, and Testing Services

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute a task order with Psomas Company to provide construction management, inspection, and testing services for the Pond Levee Maintenance Project (CIP 20707) in the amount of \$178,450.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Psomas Company will provide third party construction management, inspection, and testing services during construction of the Pond Levee Maintenance Project. Psomas's scope of work includes providing full time staffing to monitor the contractor's work for compliance with the contract documents. The consultant's work also includes coordinating work, conducting project meetings, maintaining project record drawings, preparing daily inspection reports, conducting compaction testing, and reviewing monthly progress payments.
