# **RECOMMENDATION**

Authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute a task order with GHD to provide engineering services during construction for the Browns Valley Trunk Project (CIP 14703) in the amount of \$522,720, when appropriate.

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

GHD will provide engineering services during construction of the Browns Valley Trunk Project (CIP 14703). GHD's scope of work includes environmental services, review of product and material submittals, responding to contractor requests for information and clarifications, attendance at construction and site meetings as needed, and preparation of record drawings.

GHD prepared the environmental document for the project and is the engineer of record for the design of the project and they are the most qualified to perform the listed services during construction.

A detailed scope of work is included in the attachments.

### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Work on the project began with an alignment study in 2014. Based on the results of the alignment study, the pipeline design started in 2016. NapaSan originally planned to start construction of the project in 2017 but extended the project design and outreach schedule to take advantage of SRF funding opportunities. GHD prepared the design documents and the environmental documents for the project. A similar item went to the Board in 2019 however the task order was never executed due to a delay in SRF funding.
