SUBJECT: Approve Memorandum of Understanding for the Napa Valley Drought Contingency Plan

RECOMMENDATION

Approve Memorandum of Understanding for the Napa Valley Drought Contingency Plan and authorize the Chair to sign the agreement between NapaSan and the City of Napa.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

There is a need to conduct a regional effort to determine current water supplies and demands, develop a drought monitoring process, and identify mitigation actions and projects to respond to drought conditions. A \$200,000 Drought Contingency Planning Grant from the Bureau of Reclamation is available to prepare this County-wide study.

The City of Napa, City of American Canyon, Town of Yountville, City of St Helena, City of Calistoga, Napa County, and NapaSan are participating in the study and will share costs not covered by the grant. The cost for NapaSan is \$10,118. The study will be performed by Brown & Caldwell with input from staff from each agency.

The study is expected to begin this summer and conclude in late 2021.

Where is it budgeted? \$10,200 is budgeted in the proposed FY19/20 budget to cover NapaSan's cost

share of the study.

Discretionary Justification: NapaSan is the third largest water purveyor in Napa County. Participating in

this study will help Napa County prepare and respond to future drought

conditions.

Is the general fund affected? Yes

Future fiscal impact: The study is expected to be completed in late 2021. Unspent budget will be

carried forward into future fiscal years.

Consequences if not approved: NapaSan will not participate in the study.
