ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

This engagement was conducted in conformance with the *International Standards for the Professional Practice of Internal Auditing* established by the Institute of Internal Auditors. This engagement is solely to (1) review revenue and accounts receivable associated with inbound customers; and (2) verify internal controls associated with fees collected, manual tickets issued, electronic billing, void and issuance of tickets at Devlin Road Transfer Station operated by Northern Recycling Operations & Waste Services, LLC (Northern), for the quarter ended June 30, 2020.

Based on the procedures performed, we verified that revenue and account receivable are accurately reported in the Authority's general ledger for inbound customers and internal controls associated with fees collected, manual tickets issued, electronic billing, void and replacement of tickets are adequately designed and implemented.

For quarter ended June 30, 2020, we noted there was a net cash shortage of \$95.45. The cumulative cash shortage for the fiscal year 2019-20 is \$82.12.
