### ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

#### BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The project was completed on budget and ahead of schedule. The American Canyon City staff that assisted with the project oversight did an excellent job. One change order was issued reflecting additional landscaping but also a credit for work that was removed. Thirty-five days after the Notice of Completion has been approved, and there are no outstanding liens against the contractor, the whole amount of the retention is released.

The City will be considering the warrant to repay the Authority at their November 3rd meeting. Of the total project cost of \$976,469.95, including the geotechical work, the City will be repaying \$351,322.88. Items were identified as either solely due to either the leachate line or the reclaimed water line, in which case the appropriate entity bore the full cost, or if there was joint benefit from the task a 60% for the Authority and a 40% for the City rate was determined to be equitable.

Both entities had credits from work they completed independently. In addition, the Authority paid \$66,000 into a Elliott Road Overlay fund for future improvements to Elliott Road.
