DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN

REQUESTED ACTION: Approval of Resolution #07-13 adopting the County of Napa 457 Deferred Compensation Plan and The Napa County 01(a) Retirement Saving Plan and joining the trust agreements.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Internal Revenue Code permits the provider of a deferred compensation plan to make it available to other employers who are known as "Associate Employers". Currently the County of Napa has 6 "Associate Members" and are willing to add the Napa-Vallejo Waste Management Authority's has an "Associate Member". By joining the Napa County Program the Authority participants benefit by the smaller administrative fees and larger services and products of a large fund and the County participants benefit by having a larger fund to negotiate smaller fees and expanded products and services.
