## PHWCF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

REQUESTED ACTION: Authorization for staff to release a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Operation of the Permanent Hazardous Waste Collection Facility at the Devlin Road Transfer Station.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Request for Proposals (RFP) is for the operation of the Permanent Hazardous Waste Collection Facility at the Devlin Road Transfer Station for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. The RFP is anticipated to be released on March 5, 2007, and staff expects to have both selected the contractor and have the new operations agreement ready to present to the Board for approval at the May 3, 2007 meeting.
