BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Fire Repair

This project is completed.

Leachate Transmission Line

A delay in comments from the City is pushing the release and opening date back. Staff will be discussing the potential need for a special meeting in April to approve the contract or moving the award to May.

Micro Turbine Trenching and Electrical Projects

The trenching work has been initiated with a few glitches. Electrical work has not commenced due to changes in the plans anticipated from PG&E. The schedule shows project completion in mid-April, but this may be pushed back. The new plans have been received from SCS and are being reviewed by the contractor. The electrical contractor is reviewing the revisions and we are awaiting the results of that review.

Reuse Area Improvements

Completed.

Fire Sprinkler Improvements

The Authority Manager will sign a purchase order for modifications to the fire sprinkler installation existing fire system which will comply with Fire Marshall requirements. A price under \$10,000 was received to complete the work. We have received the agreement

No winter activities at this time.

Oat Hill Quarry

Activities for this construction season have ceased and preparations for winter weather have begun. Disturbed areas have been hydro seeded.
