RECOMMENDATION

REQUESTED ACTION: Approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. 09-03 with HDR Engineering, Inc., to incorporate two additional tasks as recommended by the Authority Ad Hoc Committee, at an additional cost of \$37, 835, for a new maximum of \$61,312, with all other provisions remaining the same.

Discretionary Justification: Based on a general discussion at the Authority Board meeting on February 6,

2009, the Ad Hoc Committee, comprised of Tom Bartee and Mark

Luce, determined that it would be of benefit to the Authority to include as two

additional tasks under the HDR agreement, a review of the current management structure and a review of the proposal to use an alternative disposal site for a portion of the municipal solid waste from the Keller Canyon

Landfill site to the Forward Landfill site.

Future fiscal impact: None anticipated. The original Agreement and this requested amendment

make provisions to continue the agreement into the following 2009/2010

Fiscal Year if necessary, at the current maximum cost of \$61,312.

Consequences if not approved: The Authority will not have the benefit of a full review of its current management

structure or review of alternative disposal sites.

The Ad Hoc Committee comprised of Tom Bartee and Mark Luce, are recommending for approval by the full Authority Board, an amendment to Agreement 09-03 with HDR Engineering, Inc., to include two additional tasks, bringing the total amount of the Agreement to \$61,312, with no other changes to the terms and conditions of the original agreement as follows:

- 1. Review of the current and potential future management structure of the Authority; and
- 2. Review of a potential alternative site for disposal of a portion of municipal solid waste.
