EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The following is a summary of the Committees and their respective tasks:

Ad Hoc #1

This advisory committee was established in February 2007 to provide input to the Board and Manager on issues pertaining to the disposition of Oat Hill Quarry, the City of American Canyon's Oat Hill Master Plan, and funding DRTS C&D Phase 2 construction and to review conversion technology proposals.

Ad Hoc #2

This advisory committee was formed in October 2008 to review the current and potential future management structure of the Authority including recruitment for a manager and to review DRTS operations and make recommendations on resolving any contractual issues.
