REQUESTED ACTION: Discussion and possible adoption of an Operating and a Capital Replacement Reserve Policy for the Authority.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At the May meeting, the Executive Director recommended that the Board consider establishing Operating and Capital Replacement Reserves for the Authority. The Auditor-Controller and Executive Director have prepared draft policies for further consideration by the Board.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

At the May meeting, the Executive Director recommended that the Board consider establishing Operating and Capital Replacement Reserves for the Authority. The Auditor-Controller and Executive Director have prepared draft policies for further consideration by the Board.

The proposed Operating Reserve Policy would establish an operating reserve balance goal in a range equal to between 30-days and 90-days average cash flow. The Capital Replacement Reserve goal would be to maintain a reserve between \$1 million and \$5 million.
