SUBJECT: Agreement No. 2014-01 for Long Term Residue Disposal and ADC Capacity Services

RECOMMENDATION

2014-01 DISPOSAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

REQUESTED ACTION: Approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign Agreement No. 2014-01 with Potrero Hills Landfill, Inc. for Long Term Residue Disposal and ADC Capacity, effective January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2018 or December 31, 2023, as determined by the Board, with three 5-year renewal options.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At the May 2, 2013 meeting, the Board selected Potrero Hills Landfill, Inc. to receive waste from the Devlin Road Transfer Station (DRTS) effective January 1, 2014 when the current contract with Keller Canyon Landfill expires. Staff was directed to prepare final contract documents and return to the Board for contract approval at a subsequent meeting.

Contract documents have been prepared and approval of a contract agreement with Potrero Hills Landfill, Inc. is recommended. As directed by the Board, staff has negotiated two contract options for Board consideration: 1) a five year initial term followed by three five year options to renew; 2) a ten year initial term followed by three five year renewal options.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

At the May 2, 2013 meeting, the Board selected Potrero Hills Landfill, Inc. to receive waste from the Devlin Road Transfer Station (DRTS) effective January 1, 2014 when the current contract with Keller Canyon Landfill expires. Staff was directed to prepare final contract documents and return to the Board for contract approval at a subsequent meeting.

Contract documents have been prepared and approval of a contract agreement with Potrero Hills Landfill, Inc. is recommended. As directed by the Board, staff has negotiated two contract options for Board consideration: 1) a five year initial term followed by three five year options to renew; 2) a ten year initial term followed by three five year renewal options. The five year option has pricing consistent with the proposal submitted by Potrero Hills on March 15, 2013. The ten year option retains the same five year pricing schedule, but adds a formula for adjusting pricing during years five through ten based on annual CPI adjustments with a minimum of 2% and a maximum of 5%.

Both options are summarized in the attached exhibits. Staff recommends the Board consider approving the ten year option. It provides a reasonable approach to determining future prices and gives the Authority a known disposal site for the next ten years.
