EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Between August 2009 and September 2010, the Commission held a series of study sessions investigating options for establishing some form of limited design review process. At the conclusion of that process, the Commission expressed an interest in developing a comprehensive document containing all existing design standards and practices. On January 5, 2011, the Commission reviewed an initial draft of that document and provided comments on its organization and content. Attached to this report is the revised draft which includes the following substantive changes: 1) augmented the section on guiding principles; 2) added an implementation section; and 3) inserted placeholder section for photographs of architecture examples.

Once Commission review is complete, Staff will refer the guidelines out to local development processing professionals for review and comment. This group of stakeholders consists of architects, landscape architects, engineers, planners, land use attorneys and building contractors. Stakeholders, primarily the architects, will be asked to provide examples of good and poor architecture for inclusion in the examples section. The finalized guidelines will be provided to the Commission prior to it being available at the public counter and posted on the

Department's web page.

Although this is not a formal public hearing, the Commission is encouraged to receive comments from any interested members of the public.
