EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2011 Public Education and Information Plan - UVWMA staff, in collaboration with staff of UVDS, have updated the annual plan for education and publicity (see attachment). Staff members will use a combination of measures to inform and educate the public, including newsletters, websites, display ads, public presentations, facility tours, printed brochures, and informational tables at community events.

Home Composting Workshops - The countywide composting workshops are set to begin in March. Public workshops will be held up-valley on Sat., April 16 at the Fairgrounds in Calistoga, Sat., June 4 at the Napa Valley Museum in Yountville, Wed., August 17 at the White Barn in St. Helena, and Thurs., October 6 at the Community Center in Yountville.

- | Fluorescent Lamps – **from households only** - Central Valley Builders Supply and Steve's Hardware in St. Helena; Calistoga Fire Dept. and Clover Flat Landfill in Calistoga
- | Household Batteries - ** from households only** Napa Valley Coffee Roasting Company, Central Valley Builders Supply, and Steve's Hardware in St. Helena; Silverado Ace Hardware in Calistoga; Town Hall in Yountville; and at Clover Flat Landfill

- | Household Hazardous Waste – Annual Event at Calistoga Fairgrounds - scheduled for weekend in Oct. - *Suspended due to lack of funding*
- | Medications Disposal – Clinic Ole Offices – 661 Main St. in St. Helena; 911 Washington St. in Calistoga, during regular business hours
