## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

<u>2011 Public Education and Information Plan</u> - UVWMA staff, in collaboration with staff of UVDS, have updated the annual plan for education and publicity (see attachment). Staff members will use a combination of measures to inform and educate the public, including newsletters, websites, display ads, public presentations, facility tours, printed brochures, and informational tables at community events.

<u>Home Composting Workshops</u> - The countywide composting workshops are set to begin in March.
