DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to provide an update on the status of activities related to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The five-year review of the Integrated Waste Management Plan and its associated elements is complete, has been accepted by Napa County, and forwarded to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for their approval. No updates are required at this time. The task force will reconvene and commence the 2007 review starting in March.

As discussed in the December UVDS newsletter, UVDS is now taking many more recyclable materials, including all plastics (Numbers 1-7) and shrink wrap. They also are accepting wood pallets. Some of these items were identified by wineries as things they were looking to recycle.
