RECOMMENDATION

CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ITEM: Staff to provide and update on the status of activities related to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Notice was recently received that the information for the 2004 Annual Report was available so that we can proceed with completion of that report.

Starting 2006, staff will provide a year-end summary of integrated waste programs and activities undertaken the previous year at the January meeting.

The County has been informed that a template for the 5-year review of the Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan Review Report is available, and that the five year review for 1997 through 2002 should be prepared. This report will include a review of all the jurisdictions' documents that were prepared for source reduction and recycling element, household hazardous waste element, and non-disposal facility element, and also the County's facility siting element and summary plan. The process concludes with a determination as to whether the current planning documents are sufficiently updated (through the jurisdictions' annual reports) or if one or more of the documents need to be revised and the basis for that decision. The Local Task Force plays a key role in providing written comments on the County's report and recommendations.
