EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

We are continuing discussions on the rate reviews.

Attached are the monthly reports for September. We have met with the franchise to refine the reports, but still encourage comments from the Board to improve the forms.

One more drip hose recycling event is planned for Friday October 28 and in addition, large quantity drip hose generators can contact the franchisee to arrange for recycling services prior to that event. The October 25th Agricultural Container Recycling event was canceled.

The tire recycling grant that was received by the County will be moving up valley in November. For the month of November up to 19 tires per customer will be accepted for free at the Landfill with the coupon.
