RECOMMENDATION

CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to provide an update on the status of activities relevant to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Grants and State Payment Funds - The state (CalRecycle) has distributed 2009-10 beverage container and litter reduction funds (formerly, "DOC" funds). All up-valley cities have forwarded their share of these funds to Upper Valley Waste Management Agency. About \$20,000 of the \$25,000 pool of funds is available for UVA beverage container recycling and litter abatement projects. UVA staff is working with member communities to purchase recycling containers for public spaces (Yountville, Calistoga), recycling containers for schools (St. Helena) and special events (County). According to CalRecycle staff, the next payment of state funds will be distributed to local agencies in June, 2010.

Composting Workshops - The 2009-2010 home composting series has been completed. City of Napa staff is preparing a summary of results. UVA staff will present this to the Board at a future meeting along with a proposal for UVWMA co-sponsorship of the next spring-fall program year.

- | Agricultural Irrigation Hose - Whitehall Lane Recycling Facility - semi-annual - ***UVDS has not yet selected calendar dates for 2010-11, but they do intend to restart these events.***
- | Computers and Electronics - accepted at Clover Flat Landfill - daily
- | Fluorescent Lamps* - residents can drop-off tubes and compact bulbs at Central Valley Builders Supply and

Steve's Hardware in St. Helena; and Silverado Ace Hardware, Calistoga Fire Dept., and Clover Flat Landfill in Calistoga

- | Household Batteries*- accepted at Napa Valley Roasting Company, Central Valley Builders Supply, and Steve's Hardware in St. Helena; Clover Flat Landfill and Silverado Ace Hardware in Calistoga; Town Hall in Yountville
- | Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event** - Calistoga Fairgrounds - typically scheduled for Oct - ***no events scheduled until funding identified.*** Residents and some businesses that generate small amounts of HHW can use Devlin Rd. HHW Facility in American Canyon (see phone book recycling guide for map and details)
- | Motor Oil and Oil Filter Recycling** - used oil and filter collections sites are at PUC in Angwin, Fulton Av. in St. Helena, Yountville Corp. Yard, and Clover Flat Landfill (see phone book recycling guide for details)
