RECOMMENDATION

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Agency Manager requests Board direction in development of a policy on waiver of fees.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Currently UVDS receives requests from schools, non-profits, and others requesting free or reduced priced service. UVDS often grants those requests. The Agency Manager is concerned that, absent a formal policy, the company is placed in the position of having to individually evaluate each request, and that these decisions ultimately impact rates since service provided free to one party is in fact paid for by the other rate payers.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Agency Manager is concerned that, absent a formal policy, the company is placed in the position of having to individually evaluate each request, and that these decisions ultimately impact rates since service provided free to one party is in fact paid for by the other rate payers. A partial list of recently granted requests is attached.

The Agency Manager requests Board input on:

- Does the Board desire to establish a policy?
- If so, what types of organizations should be granted waivers and under what conditions?
- Does the Board desire to establish limits (i.e. amount per request or a total for each operating year)?
- What type of service should be provided (i.e. solid waste, recycling, green, etc.per request or in total)?
- How often does the Board desire to be informed of the amount of such requests (quarterly?)

Once Board direction is provided, the Agency Manager will draft a policy for review by the Board at a future meeting.
