#### Waste Reduction and Recycling Activities Update

Home Composting Workshops - The countywide composting workshop season has begun. Sponsors have scheduled four workshops for up-valley: Sat., April 16 at Calistoga Community Center; Sat., June 4 at Napa Valley Museum in Yountville, Wed., August 17 at The White Barn in St. Helena, and Thurs., October 6 at the Community Center in Yountville. Agricultural Chemical Container Recycling Event – the Napa County Agricultural Commissioner’s Office has sponsored plastic pesticide container recycling collection events since 1994. The agency has scheduled an event for this spring - Monday, April 25, at the County Corporation Yard in Yountville. Participants can drop-off plastic pesticide containers at no charge. Refer questions to the Ag. Commissioner’s Office at 253-4357.

Irrigation Hose Recycling Collections – Upper Valley Disposal and Recycling Service will conduct two plastic irrigation hose recycling events this year at its Materials Recovery Facility at Whitehall Lane. Participants may drop-off plastic hose at no charge. UVDRS has scheduled the events for Friday, May

Up-valley Regular Drop-off Recycling and Waste Collections

- | Computers and Electronics – Clover Flat Landfill – daily, during business hours
- | Fluorescent Lamps – from households only - Central Valley Builders Supply and Steve’s Hardware in St. Helena; Calistoga Fire Station, Silverado Ace Hardware, and Clover Flat Landfill in Calistoga, during regular business hours
- | Household Batteries - from households only - Napa Valley Coffee Roasting Company, Central Valley Builders Supply, and Steve's Hardware in St. Helena; Silverado Ace Hardware and Clover Flat Landfill in Calistoga; Town Hall in Yountville, during regular business hours
- | Household Hazardous Waste – Annual Event at Calistoga Fairgrounds – typically scheduled for weekend in Oct. - *Suspended due to lack of funds*
- | Medications Disposal – Up-valley residents can drop-off their old and unwanted medications at Clinic Ole Offices – 661 Main St. in St. Helena; 911 Washington St. in Calistoga, during regular business hours
