# **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

# Monthly Financial Report

The most recent financial report is attached. At one point earlier this year I reported that landfill surcharge revenue was projected to be about \$10,000 under our \$170,000 budget. That problem has dramatically fixed itself, and we are now \$442,000 over our planned revenue estimate. This will be discussed further when we plan next year's

budget at the May meeting.

# Communications From Customers

The high level of activity at the landfill has occasionally caused the tracking of mud onto Silverado Trail. The County and the Company have met to discuss solutions to this problem, both in the short and longer term.

#### **Update On Contract Revisions**

Per Board direction, Counsel has been working on an administrative update of the Franchise Agreements for UVDS and CFL. We believe we have a finished document in concept for UVDS. My goal is to clean up the document and have it ready for Board approval at the May meeting. We are commencing review of the CFL agreement. These efforts were delayed by the Fires, but good progress is now being made.
