RECOMMENDATION

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGENCY AGREEMENT #07-06 (PSC/ 21st Century EMI)

DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEM: Approval and authorization for the Agency Manager to sign the fist amendment to Agency Agreement #07-06 with Philip Services and 21st Century EMI, in the amount of \$30,000.00, to provide for the collection, transportation and disposal of household hazardous waste through the conductance of a temporary collection event, and from select locations through the end of the fiscal year.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposal will allow Philip Services Corporation and 21st Century Environmental Management Inc. of Nevada to continue to provide household hazardous waste collection, transportation, and disposal services through the end of the fiscal year.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The original PSC/21st Century EMI agreement was approved by the Board in the sum of \$30,000 per fiscal year at their meeting of September 17, 2007 with an expiration date of

June 30, 2010. The agreement is for the collection, transportation, and disposal of household hazardous waste through temporary collection events and from select locations. This first amendment of \$30,000 (bringing the total authorized agreement for this fiscal year to \$60,000) is to allow PSC /21st Century to conduct a second temporary collection event and to continue to provide for the collection, transportation and disposal of household hazardous waste from select locations through the end of this fiscal year.
