## **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

SB 1020, which would require communities to achieve a 75% diversion rate (instead of the 50% currently required

under AB 939) is working its way through Sacramento. Staff will continue to track this legislation.

Treated wood waste, which was banned from landfills some time ago, remains a disposal challenge for some of our citizens. Disposal for treated wood waste is available at Altamont and Keller Canyon Landfills, and at B&J Disposal in Vacaville.
