EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Compost Workshops

These are occurring, with three up valley workshops this summer.

Large Venue Recycling

Further determination of the needs and related purchases are occurring.

Annual Member Report

Manager will be developing a format for an annual fiscal year report for distribution to the member jurisdictions in the fall. This was intended to primarily be a fiscal report, but it could also be an opportunity to highlight some of the Agency's activities. Input from the Board Members on what they would like in this report would be appreciated.

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events

The Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event was May 27 in Rutherford and the next event is October 21 in Calistoga. Some preliminary numbers are:

- 107 cars
- 1000 lbs of pesticides
- 850 lbs of aerosol cans (spray paint, cleaners)

- 4250 lbs of paint related materials (oil base paint, stains, tars, adhesives, caulking)
- 1600 lbs of corrosive liquids (pool acid, cleaners)
- 1 13 5-gallon propane cylinders
- 1 10 gallons of antifreeze
- 1 30 gallons of motor oil

Recycling Enclosures

Staff is still exploring information on this topic. The City of Napa has hired a consultant to assist them with developing an ordinance. Staff will be involved with this process in order to provide for consistency across the County. More information should be available by this Fall.
