CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to provide an update on the status of activities relevant to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Grants and Payment Funds - The state (CalRecycle) has notified Napa County that it will restore recycling and litter reduction payments for fiscal years 2009-2010 and 2010-2011. The full amount of the grant is \$25,000 per year (with approximately \$20,000 of that allocated to the upvalley area), so \$50,000 total should be available for beverage container recycling activities over the next fiscal year. However, as of writing this agenda item CalRecycle has not yet released these funds.

Composting Workshops - The composting workshop program includes one more class in the up-valley area. It will be held on Saturday, August 28 at 9:00 a. m. at the White Barn in St. Helena. Sign-ups are accepted at <http://cityofnapa.org/compost>
