Another drip hose recycling event was held on July 29 which generated 17 tons of baled drip hose for recycling. This event went very smooth and is providing a much appreciated services for the farming community. One more event is planned for later this summer and in addition, large quantity drip hose generators can contact the franchisee to arrange for recycling services prior to that event.
