DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to provide an update on the status of activities relevant to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

<u>Grants and Payment Funds</u> - The state (CalRecycle) has distributed 2009-2010 beverage container and litter reduction funds (formerly DOC funds). Almost all recipient up-valley cities have forwarded their local share of funds to Upper Valley Waste Management Agency. We should have all \$25,000 by the end of the month. It is unclear when 2010-2011 funds will be distributed.

<u>Composting Workshops</u> - The countywide home composting workshop program includes one more class in the up-valley area. It will be held on Saturday, August 28 at 9:00 a. m. at the White Barn in St. Helena. The class is currently full with a waiting list.
