BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Monthly Financial Reports

Report for the completed fiscal year is attached. A few highlights:

Revenue collected was \$182,118, or \$3,506 under the budgeted amount of \$185,625.

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Expenses were \$174,363, or \$11,261 under the budgeted amount of \$185,625.

As such, \$7,754 was added to reserves.

\$33,028 was collected for HHW events. Approximately \$35,000 was actually spent (the difference being covered by savings in other line items).

Purchase of Anti-litter Cameras

The County is considering the purchase of video cameras to deter vandalism, grafitti, and illegal dumping around various county facilities. There is an opportunity for UVA to join in this order, should the the UVA Board have an interest in purchase of cameras to discourgae littering and illegal dumping in the UVA geographic area. Approximate cost would \$10,000 dollars for about a dozen cameras, which (by a separate Board action) could be transferred from reserves. The Agency Manager requests input from the Board as to whether to pursue such an arrangement.
