Oil Filter Recycling

Staff and the company have successfully rolled out a program to collect used oil filters via the standard curbside oil recycling program at the 3 publicly run farm worker centers.

The Fall newsletter is being prepared and will include articles on recycling of plastic as well as the new commercial recycling program which provides for additional recycling containers at no charge. The Company reports that there has been a high level of interest in this program.
